1. INTRODUCTION

- 1.1 This Cookie policy describes how Lindab AB ("**Lindab**"), save and handle cookies when you visit or enter information in connection with your use of LindQST ("**the Applications**") and how you can contact us if you have additional questions.

2. COOKIES

- 2.1 A 'cookie' is a small text file containing information which is stored on your computer. Cookies are used for technical reasons and to facilitate your use of a website. One type of cookie will save a file permanently on your computer. It can thereafter be used to customise this website based on the user's choices and interests. Another common type of cookie is the "session cookie". When you visit a website, session cookies are sent between your computer and the server to collect information. Session cookies are not saved once you close your web browser. For more information about how cookies work, please be referred to www.allaboutcookies.org. Please note that the referred website is independent to Lindab and that Lindab is not responsible for its content.
- 2.2 Below is a list of the cookies used by Lindab for the Webtools. The five first mentioned cookies (a, b, c, d and e) are necessary for the functions of the Webtools.
 - a) .ASPXANONYMOUS (session) a cookie which stores role names for users, in order to tell the role of the logged-on user. Only used for websites with a password protected area.
 - b) .ASPXAUTH (expires after 2 days) used in order to determine if a user is authorised to access or not and, only once a user has logged on. Used for websites with a password protected area only.
 - c) ASP.NET_SessionId (session) is a cookie which is used to identify the users session on the server.
 - d) ARRAffinity (session) used to aid people who need to stay with a certain instance of web app or web site in Azure (backward compatibility).
 - e) ARRAffinitySameSite (session) used to aid people who need to stay with a certain instance of web app or web site in Azure.
 - f) _anonymous_user_ (expires after 6 months) used to save which project the user is using when the user is logged in.
 - g) Cookieconsent_status (expires after 12 months) used to remember if the user has clicked on "Accept cookies".





- h) _lq_latest_changes_ (expires after 7 days) used to remember if the user has clicked on "OK" after viewing latest news.
- i) _lq_market (expires after 13 months) used to save which market the user has chosen.
- 2.3 We are continuously working to improve the Webtools. In order to do this, we use Google Analytics to analyse our users behavior on an anonymous and aggregated level.
- 2.4 We also allow our web analysis tool, Google Analytics, to place and manage cookies on this website. The following cookies are placed by Google Analytics to log data about visits and visitors of this website. The statistics are used to improve the user experience of this website:
 - _ga (expires after 13 months) used to store and count pageviews and to distinguish users.
 - _ga_F49EWMYWK8 (expires after 13 months) used to persist session state.
- 2.5 If you do not wish to accept cookies you can change your web browser's settings to automatically deny the storage of cookies or to inform you when a website wants to store cookies on your computer. Previously stored cookies can also be deleted through the web browser (for more on this see below under 6). Please note that certain areas and functions on this website require cookies and may not function if cookies are deleted or declined.
- 2.6 If you wish to remove the cookies that are already on your equipment, and you are using a PC and a newer browser, you can press CTRL + SHIFT + DELETE simultaneously. If this shortcut does not work, you can find the support pages for the most commonly used browsers as well as a link to delete flash-cookies here:
